

**Minutes of the Meeting of the
Lincoln Township Board
Thursday, April 9, 2026**

The regular monthly meeting of the Lincoln Township Board was held at the Lincoln Township Hall. The Meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by Supervisor Gerald Wenkel. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll call was taken with Supervisor Gerald Wenkel, Treasurer Manda Haas, Clerk Kristie Damron, Trustee Brenda Damron, and Trustee Noreen Walter attending.

The meeting minutes from March were presented and read. Treasurer Haas made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Seconded by Trustee Walter. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's Report was submitted by Treasurer Haas. Clerk Damron made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented. Seconded by Trustee Damron. Motion carried.

Correspondence was received from ProScape with information regarding lawncare services. The board is currently waiting on additional bids from Coughlin Lawncare and Big John's for landscaping services. Trustee Walter made a motion to have Coughlin Lawncare continue to mow the grass for the summer and put out bids for snow removal. Seconded by Clerk Damron. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Treasurer Haas to pay the bills as presented. Seconded by Trustee Damron. Motion carried.

The meeting was open to the public with zero (0) citizens in attendance.

The Fire Authority report was given.

There was no Assessor's report given.

Zoning Administrator, Brenda Matt, gave the zoning report as follows:

- 3 permits were given
- Permits were sent to Denise
- Land splits received for Saunders
- Freedom Rental told Prime Tree Service that Lincoln Township removed their sign and fined them \$1,000.00. Lincoln Township did not take these actions.
- No further information was received regarding Roberto Cortez. Matt stated that she would reach out to the lawyer's office on the status of the documentation.
- Complaints received regarding the following properties:
 - 4641 W Duprie – Several unregistered/unlicensed vehicles on property. Letter sent asking to remove the vehicles
 - 3777 Johnson Road – Several unregistered/unlicensed vehicles on property. Matt will send a letter to the homeowner

Unfinished Business:

Road brining was discussed. Treasurer Haas made a motion to complete one (1) pass twice on most dirt roads. The roads that receive more traffic (Irwin Road, Melita Road, Wheeler Road, and Deep River Road) will receive two (2) passes twice. Seconded by Clerk Damron. Motion carried.

Graveling an additional road was discussed. Treasurer Haas made a motion to gravel Sagatoo Road from Lincoln Road east to the dead end at a cost of approximately \$9,240 to the township. Seconded by Clerk Damron. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn made by Treasurer Haas. Seconded by Clerk Damron. Meeting adjourned at 6:47 PM. The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, May 14th at 6:00 PM at the Lincoln Township Hall.
